India Mobile Congress 2022 (IMC-2022), the 6th Edition of Asia's largest Digital Technology Event, is being organized by the Department of Telecommunications (DOT), Ministry of Communications, Government of India in association with Cellular Operator Association of India (COAI) from 1-3 October, 2022, at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.
