Participation of Indian delegation led by the Plexconcil in the Expo Plast Peru held in Lima from 24 to 27 August, 2022

An Indian delegation led by the Plastics Export Promotion Council (Plexconcil) participated in the Expo Plast Peru held in Lima from 24 to 27 August, 2022. The Indian companies showcased their products such as PP Woven Bags, FIBC, Bopp Laminated PP Woven Bags, Flexible Laminated Pouches and Rolls; white, black, colour and additive master batches; Rotomoulding Machine, Sheet Metal Moulds, Ancillary Machines; Cleaning tools and equipment; Rubber Rolls, Polyurethane Products, Recycled Plastic Products, Prepolymer (TDI/Ester); Plastic Extrusion Machinery; Geo and Agro Textile.

At the inauguration of India Pavilion, Ambassador Subbarayudu Mandarapu welcomed the participation of Indian companies and outlined significant opportunities for enhancing the export of Plastics and related products to Peru from India. He urged the Indian industry to continue and further expand their business focus in partnership with the Embassy of India in Lima so that the current market share can be increased substantially this financial year. Mr. Juan Matsusita, President, Peruvian Association of Plastics Industry (APIPLAST) joined the event. Cooperation between Plexconcil and APIPLAST, including the possibility of MOU was discussed.

3. The bilateral trade between India and Peru has touched US\$ 3.6 billion in the Financial Year 2021-22. India's plastics exports to Peru primarily comprise of Plastic raw materials (50%), Plastic films & sheets & (24%), and medical disposables (6%).
